



Michel Akl



A melange of abstracted figures, forms, and playful geometries coalesce into a composition by Michel Akl that is psychologically charged.

A Lebanese artist born in 1940, Akl developed a distinctive language rooted in expressionism and surrealism, influenced by vernacular visual culture. Self-taught yet sophisticated in his command of form and colour, Akl's practice resists easy categorisation. His compositions often fuse folkloric motifs with cosmological symbols.

In this work, Akl shows us his interest in the intersections of the psyche, mythology, and play. The juxtapositions of mask-like faces, circular constellations, and disjointed limbs recall the hybrid vocabulary and post-war French artist Jean Dubuffet and early CoBrA figures. Faces emerge and dissolve, some are rendered with a childlike directness while others are more cryptic, suggesting both joy and menace. By applying a flatness to the pictorial frame and by avoiding perspectival depth, Akl evokes an influence from post-cubist modernism. The circular motifs and fragmented forms hint at a personal iconography: wheels, eyes, suns, and astrological signs function as visual punctuation marks across the surface.

The painting, which strives for ambiguity, is simultaneously humorous and enigmatic. It exemplifies Akl's practice that has contributed to the history of post-war Lebanese painting, influenced by Western avant-garde movements and enriched by personal visual elements.





Willy Aractingi

(1930–2003)

In *Le Phoque éperdu* (The Distraught Seal) (1983), Willy Aractingi (1930–2003) represents one of Beirut's most renowned landmarks in a composition that borders on the surreal. The iconic Pigeons' Rock, Beirut's natural monument jutting from the Mediterranean Sea, is rendered here with a childlike purity, with bold colour blocks of ultramarine, rose, and ivory pink that strip the Pigeon's Rock from its geological naturalism and reimagines it as a metaphysical form floating in the sea. The work's title adds a note of melancholy or irony that invites viewers to perceive the work as an allegory of estrangement. Whether the titular seal is present metaphorically or as the tiny creature perched on the lower left cliff, the title recasts the scene in the realm of the poetic and the absurd.

A self-taught artist of Lebanese descent, Aractingi spent much of his career navigating between his two lives as a painter and a writer. Though best known for his 100-painting series illustrating the *One Thousand and One Nights*, Aractingi's work consistently oscillated between narrative painting and symbolic abstraction. In this work, Aractingi turns to his native Lebanese landscape as a site of imagination, one where allegory and memory converge. The small green parrot perched on the left and the whimsical palm tree on the right introduce a note of fantasy, undermining any naturalism.

This composition is characterised by a deliberate naïveté, a feature central to Aractingi's mature style. His use of unmodulated colour fields and stylised forms resonate with the traditions of modernist primitivism, and yet here, Aractingi localises these influences within a Lebanese context.

Le Phoque éperdu is not a depiction of Beirut's coastline, but a vision of playful reinvention. Aractingi does not offer a mere view of the city but a vision of it that is imbued with tenderness, with a touch of surrealism.

Anas Albraeche

(b. 1991)

Rendered in dense impasto and structured with a composition of bold chromatic contrasts, this work by Syrian artist Anas Albraeche (b. 1991) reflects the emotive power and subtle resistance that define his practice. The main subject of the painting is seated and enveloped in a voluminous yellow robe adorned with scattered orange dots. Her head tilts dramatically to the side, resting against a raised arm, while her distant and luminous gaze hovers vulnerably.

With thick brushstrokes that oscillate between expressive figuration and near-abstraction, Albraeche's treatment of the surface recalls the post-impressionist focus on texture and expressive colours. The disproportionate emphasis on the figure's large garment, rendered with almost obsessive repetition of dappled strokes, transforms the piece of cloth into a landscape, simultaneously obscuring and amplifying the body.

Albraeche is best known for his long-term series of sleeping figures from marginalised communities, such as migrant workers and refugees who are often caught in moments of rest amidst social precarity. Born in 1991 in Syria and currently based in Beirut, his practice offers a potent form of visual testimony and socio-political critique. This painting, however, extends beyond the subject of sleep and rest, to explore the existential postures of pause, weariness, and reverie.

What renders this canvas particularly poignant is the way it negotiates figuration through pattern. The saturated blue and acid green background partitions the pictorial space into abstraction. The flattened perspective and compressed bodily posture destabilize traditional portraiture, situating the work within contemporary discourses on the representation of the marginalized. Albraeche's work has been exhibited internationally and is increasingly sought after by collectors attuned to politically engaged figuration in contemporary Arab art.
